1. Apply for graduation	16-Sep-22	This is the last day for graduate students to apply for graduation online. Go to Graduate Progress under tools Apply for Graduation.
2. Confirm approval	30-Sep-22	This is the last day for departments to accept a student's graduation application in AIM.
3. Schedule your thesis defense	At least two days before your defense Ideally by 29-Nov-22	Contact your committee to determine a date and time all can attend. Email this information to Mary Beth at linguistics@byu.edu to schedule. Scheduling the defense earlier leaves more time to make corrections.
4. Pass your oral defense	Ideally by 30-Nov-22 No later than 7-Dec-22	After your oral defense, your committee will go online to GradProg to mark result of defense.
5a. Make Revisions 5b. Get approval to submit ETD	Ideally by 7-Dec-22	Committee approves thesis as passed in GradProg.
6. Submit your ETD	Ideally by 7-Dec-22 No later than 14-Dec-22	Submit your ETD in GradProg for first clearance by Graduate Studies.
7a. Make corrections 7b. Resubmit 7c. Repeat until approved	Ideally by 9-Dec-22 Not after* 16-Dec-22	This is the last day for the College to approve your ETD. * Warning! 3. Schedule your thesis defense	At least two days before your defense Ideally by 8-Apr-23	Contact your committee to determine a date and time all can attend. Email this information to Mary Beth at linguistics@byu.edu to schedule. Scheduling the defense earlier leaves more time to make corrections.
4. Pass your oral defense	Ideally by 9-Apr-23 No later than 16-Apr-23	After your oral defense, your committee will go online to GradProg to mark result of defense.
5a. Make Revisions 5b. Get approval to submit ETD	Ideally by 16-Apr-23	Committee approves thesis as passed in GradProg.
6. Submit your ETD	Ideally by 16-Apr-23 No later than 25-Apr-23	Submit your ETD in GradProg for first clearance by Graduate Studies.

3. Schedule your thesis defense	At least two days before your defense Ideally by 21-May-23	Contact your committee to determine a date and time all can attend. Email this information to Mary Beth at linguistics@byu.edu to schedule. Scheduling the defense earlier leaves more time to make corrections.
4. Pass your oral defense	Ideally by 24-May-23 No later than 2-Jun-23	After your oral defense, your committee will go online to GradProg to mark result of defense.
5a. Make Revisions 5b. Get approval to submit ETD	Ideally by 7-Jun-23	Committee approves thesis as passed in GradProg.

2. Confirm approval	30-Jun-23	This is the last day for departments to accept a student's graduation application in AIM.
3. Schedule your thesis defense	At least two days before your defense Ideally by 18-Jul-23	Contact your committee to determine a date and time all can attend. Email this information to Mary Beth at linguistics@byu.edu to schedule. Scheduling the defense earlier leaves more time to make corrections.
4. Pass your oral defense	Ideally by 19-Jul-23 No later than 26-Jul-23	After your oral defense, your committee will go online to GradProg to mark result of defense.
5a. Make Revisions 5b. Get approval to submit ETD	Ideally by 2-Aug-23	Committee approves thesis as passed in GradProg.
6. Submit your ETD	Ideally by 3-Aug-23 No later than 9-Aug-23	Submit your ETD in GradProg for first clearance by Graduate Studies.
